Representatives from Nagoya's sister and friendship cities of Los Angeles, Mexico City, Nanjing, Sydney, Torino and Reims will make an appearance in convertible cars.



6 Nana-chan Team

Oct. 19(Sat) & 20(Sun)

This parade features Nana-chan, the symbolic doll located in front of Nagoya Station.



7 Sports and Culture Parade

Oct. 20(Sun)

Sports teams active throughout Japan and Cultural activity groups will join together in a parade.

8 Procession of the Three Feudal Lords

Oct. 19(Sat) & 20(Sun)

A fife and drum band of children lead the way, followed by the gorgeous Shachi Bayashi Troupe. After that, there will be troops led by Oda Nobunaga, who paved the way to unifying Japan. Toyotomi Hideyoshi, who was born in Owari region and ruled the entire country, and finally Tokugawa Ieyasu, who laid the foundation for the 300 years of prosperity of the Tokugawa Shogunate, will finish the procession.
