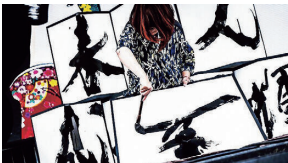

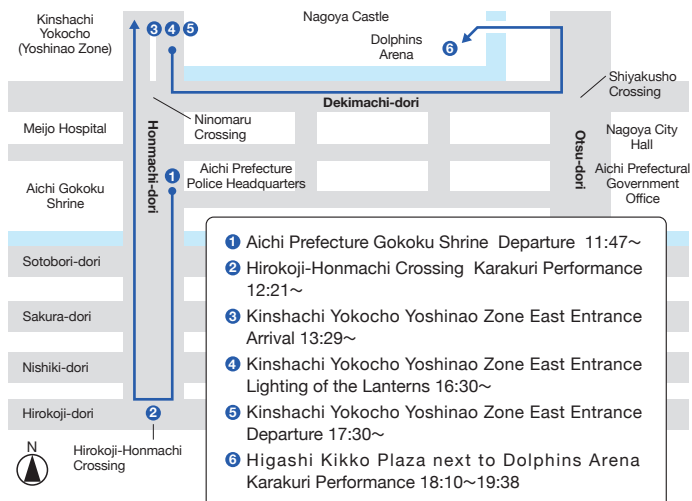

Honmachi-dori Dashi Float Parade and Evening Dashi Float Parade

Oct. 19(Sat) 11:50 am to 2:50pm
5:30 pm to 8:00pm

During the day, 9 dashi floats will pass through Honmachi-dori, and display their Karakuri mechanical dolls in a performance near the Hirokoji-Honmachi crossing. Panels illustrating the history of Honmachi-dori, the former main street, will be on display along the roadside, along with areas to enjoy food and street performance. In the evening, dashi floats lit with lanterns will make their way to the Higashi Kikko Plaza next to Dolphins Arena from the Kinshachi Yokocho Yoshinao Zone East Entrance. In this dream-like atmosphere, they will display their Karakuri mechanical dolls. Make sure you don't miss the extravagant dashi float parade and traditional Karakuri performance in celebration of the 70th anniversary!



Nagoya Castle

Oct. 19(Sat) & 20(Sun) 9:00 am to 4:30 pm

Nagoya Castle is one of Japan's most prominent castles, and is designated a National Historic Site, considered the equivalent of being a National Treasure.

The Honmaru Place – formally used as lodging for shogun – was restored in June, 2018. And The Kinshachi Yokocho, a commercial complex, opened in March, 2018 with areas near the Main Gate and East Gate of Nagoya Castle.
